You may have noticed that you haven't received a Riviera Living magazine of late and be wondering why. The publisher of the magazine, N2R Publishing is re-organizing and will not be producing another issue until sometime in the 2nd half of 2013. So we are publishing our own newsletter, Riviera Reporter in the meantime.

Since you last heard from us we have been busy with several projects. We awarded scholarships to 3 outstanding South high graduates; Jaime Savitz, Curren Clune and Brett Hoffman. There is a photo of theses gifted youngsters in this edition and also on our website at www.hollywoodriviera.org.

We met with Mayor Scotto in March to discuss the need for an ordinance to protect our views from obstruction by trees and other vegetation. Then in May members of the Board and concerned homeowners attended the City Council Meeting where we submitted signed petitions, presented speakers and formally requested that the city draft a view ordinance. Following up on those activities, we then met with Councilman Brewer and later with Concilman Bill Sutherland to get their feedback on the ordinance issue. Next steps include a meeting of interested volunteers which will be held on Sep 24 at 513 Camino de Encanto at 7:00 pm, and a meeting by the Board Presidents with the remaining Council Members.

Over the summer we compiled and catalogued 77 years of historical documents from the Riviera HOA newsletters and meetings. Minutes, photos and other fascinating documents have been sent to the Torrance Historical Society where you can now go to view this wonderful collection. Thanks to Anne Obrien and Lisa Edmundson for their guidance and assistance with this project.

On August 25 we brought back Movies in the Park at El Retiro Park with a showing of Kung Fu Panda. What a great way to wrap up the summer! We are looking forward to seeing many of you in October at our general meeting, "Filmed in the Riviera," featuring special guest speakers Marty Cohen, Bruce McKaig and lots of familiar sights on film.

The new large flagstone courtyard secures their two small children and two dogs. It is used for entertaining, lots of play time and is flooded with color including: Princess Flower (TIBOUCHINA urvilleana), Flax (PHORMIUM hybrid), Pygmy Date Palm (PHOENIX roebelenii), Ginger, Canna, Angel's Trumpet (BRUGMANSIA 'Charles Grimaldi'), Purple Banana (ENSETE ventricosum 'Maurelii'), Trumpet Vine (DISTICTIS), Euphorbia, and Geranium. The home is very welcoming and lushly private - their tropical paradise.
