

The Hillside Overlay Ordinance,

part of the Torrance Municipal Code, provides an extra layer of protection from overbuilding in this part of the R-1 zone. The Hillside and Coastal Ordinance guidelines are in the Municipal Code beginning at Section 91.41.1

The entire Hillside Overlay Ordinance, including its restrictions and limitations, are available if you search the internet for "Torrance Hillside Overlay".



What are the restrictions?

Because this is a special environment, protections are in place to uphold the key values of view, light, air, and privacy in this area. If you wish to exceed the height beyond one-story and/or size limitations in the Ordinance, you must apply for permits using the Precise Plan process.

These protections also extend to fencing, rooftop decks, window placement and other features. These restrictions are in place to avoid impacting other homes nearby.

Exceptions to these restrictions may be



granted in some cases, but you will need to have them approved by the Planning Commission.

What are the benefits?

Living in an area with an Overlay Ordinance and a Precise Plan requirement comes with benefits and responsibilities for homeowners.



Air, light, views, and privacy key values upheld by the Hillside Overlay Ordinance

The Ordinance states that your view, light, air, and privacy are protected from a neighbor remodeling their home and impacting you and your home. Conversely, if you wish to remodel your home, you need to avoid impacting the view, light, air, and privacy of your neighbors.





Communicate with neighbors!

The best way to successfully remodel while continuing to have a good relationship with neighbors is to talk with them EARLY in the process, before you have had an architect draw up a

blueprint. Let your neighbors know what your plans are, show some rough ideas or photos of other homes that have the features that you would like.



Ask if they have any concerns or questions and, most importantly, let them know that you are willing to work with them.

Stay in touch during the remodeling and building process. In this way, you can update and upgrade your home while maintaining good relations with your neighbors and other people in this beautiful community.
